TRAVEL

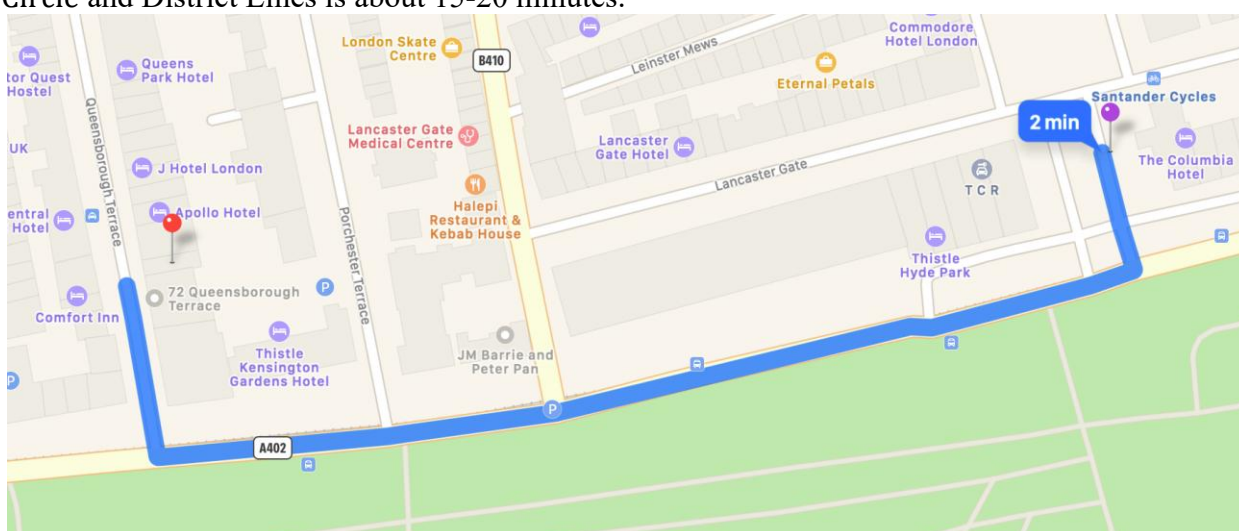
The venue is a bed and breakfast, a short walk from the venue we've used in previous years, the Columbia Hotel. It is still only about a 10-minute walk from Paddington Station (a major station for both rail and underground trains). Paddington is a 15-minute train ride from Heathrow Airport on the Heathrow Express, which goes to Terminals 1,2,3 & 5. It no longer goes to Terminal 4. There is also a train from Heathrow Terminals 1,2,3, & 4 to

Paddington Station called the Heathrow Connect, which takes about 30 minutes to Paddington Station—it is a local train that runs about every half hour and makes about 5 stops but goes directly to Paddington without you having to change trains; it is much cheaper than the Heathrow Express. You can also get to Paddington by underground from Heathrow. This is cheaper yet, but slower, taking about 45 minutes, and involves changing trains, which is not fun with luggage.

The venue is also just a 3-minute walk from the Queensway Underground Station on the Central Line, and a short walk from the Lancaster Gate Underground Station on the Central Line, or the Bayswater Underground Station on the Circle and District Lines. The London Underground is old, though, and sometimes stations are closed for a while, or on certain days, for repairs. You can call London travel information for details at: 020 7222 1234. The map below shows its relation to the Columbia Hotel, which most of you would be familiar with.

The closest tube station is the Lancaster Gate on the Central Line—only a few minutes walk away. Queensway on the Central Line is about 10 minutes walk, and Bayswater on the Circle and District Lines is about 15-20 minutes.



ACCOMMODATION

For lots of accommodation options search booking.com or other booking websites for “72QT” and then select the map to find other hotels nearby.

You can also choose to stay at the venue itself.

Also recommended nearby is the Lancaster Hall Hotel; 35 Craven Terrace (44) (0) 20 7723 9276 <https://www.lancaster-hall-hotel.co.uk/> This hotel is a modern clean building. Singles are the same size as doubles. They have wireless in all bedrooms. There is also a ‘youth accommodation’ section which you can inquire about as a cheaper option.
